



SOUTH FLORIDA DISCIPLES PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT

I therefore pledge to be responsible for my words and actions while attending and/or participating in a youth sports event and shall conform my behavior to the following code of conduct:

1. I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
2. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
3. I will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
4. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
5. I will not use drugs or alcohol while at a youth sports event and will not attend, coach, officiate or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
6. I will not permit my child, or encourage any other person, to use drugs or alcohol at a youth sports event and will not permit my child, or encourage any other person, to attend, coach, officiate or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
7. I will not engage in the use of profanity.
8. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in the use of profanity.
9. I will treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
10. I will encourage my child to treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
11. I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
12. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
13. I will not initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
14. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
15. I will not speak negatively about any player or parent while attending games, practices, community service, or other special events.
16. I will place the emotional and physical well being of each player, including my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
17. I will provide support for the coaches working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
18. I will not wear any clothing that promotes the use of drugs.
19. I will respectfully speak directly to the Head Coach if I have any questions regarding team issues and not speak negatively about the coaching staff. This allows issues to be handled professionally before a bigger issue is created.

20. I will try to have my child participate in **all** practices, community service, games, and special gatherings. A child that misses **too many** events may have his playing time reduced. I understand that this is not a punishment, but it rewards the players who are present consistently. If I am unable to participate, I will notify one of the coaches in advance.
21. I understand that if I fail to participate in fundraising events that my family may not be able to receive the financial benefit of the funds collected from the fundraising.
22. I understand that the program grievance procedure is posted on the team's website at www.southfloridadisciples.com.

I hereby agree that if I fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending and/ or participating in a youth sports event, I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

1. Verbal warning issued by organization.
2. Written warning issued by organization.
3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a youth sports event issued by organization or official who is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection.
4. Suspension from multiple youth sports events issued by organization or official who is authorized to issue such suspension.
5. Season suspension issued by youth sports organization.

The Board of Directors in consultation with the Founder will discuss disciplinary Decisions due to parent(s) behavior. The Founder will have the final decision to whether a child and parent will be removed from the team. In the event the parent involved is on the board then, s/he will not be allowed to participate in the discussion.
